

HOW TO PLAY "FUNNY SCRIPT"

It's a great game for creative kids or adults and can be entertaining. It is a "paper telephone" variation.

Best for: Group of about 3.

What you need: Each player will need a piece of paper and a pencil or pen to write/draw with.

How to play:

Players in a circle, it better to sit around the table, so it was easy to hold the paper and write.

- Everyone starts by writing a sentence at the top of his or her paper. It can be something random, true, abstract, from a song lyric, or about someone in the room.
- Once everyone has a sentence at the top of the paper, everyone folds the top part of the paper over so it covers the first sentence and passes their paper to the player to their right.
- Then again, everyone writes a sentence at the top of his or her paper. Again fold the top part of the paper over and pass the paper to the player to their right.

Everyone continues alternately writing sentences, always covering up the latest sentence and passing to the right.

The game lasts as many rounds as the number of players plays (or 5 rounds if fewer players are playing).

In the last round: Continue writing until everyone gets the paper at the end of the round.

After everyone is done writing, players unfold the papers they have. Then you go around as everyone one by one reads a paper out loud.

It's always funny to hear how the first sentence turned into the last one.

Here are some examples:

The kids all danced around the large oak tree.

The dog chased the carefree butterflies to the end of the rainbow. If all the raindrops were lemon drops and gumdrops, oh what a world it would be!

Ted can't find the right shoes to wear to prom.
